# Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

## Kindergarten to Year 6

❖ **In-term Swimming Lessons**

In-term swimming is held at Northam Swimming Pool. Students who have a pool pass are not required to pay entry fee but still required to pay the bus fee.

❖ **Sporting Event Entry/Bus Fee**

The sporting event fee is payable for students to attend sporting events such as Faction/Interschool carnivals and trials.

❖ **Incursions/Excursions**

The School Council recognises the value of incursions for students and seeks to support teachers who co-ordinate them as part of their teaching programs.

#### ❖ Year 6 Camp

Each year teachers offer to co-ordinate a camp for year 6 students. The School Council has agreed that the maximum charge to parents for any official camp should not exceed the figure shown.

#### ❖ Leavers Ceremony

The Year 6's have an opportunity to attend a leaver's ceremony and some money may be requested to provide a meal/disco after the ceremony.

#### ❖ Leavers Shirt

Students are given the opportunity to purchase a "leavers shirt" to wear in their last year of primary school. The Year 6 teachers will consult with students on design and order in term 1.

#### ❖ PEAC

Selected students may have the opportunity to participate in excursions during the school year.

#### ❖ Instrumental Music

Students sit a music test in year 4 for the opportunity to attend instrumental music lessons through School of Instrumental Music (SIM) in years 5 & 6. Instruments are hired through the school at a cost of \$110 per year. An additional \$40 is budgeted for excursions/text books/etc. as/if required.

#### ❖ Choir

Students audition for the opportunity to join the school choir. Occasionally there may be an opportunity to attend a Choir excursion.

# Personal Items

## Dress Code:

Parents/Carers are requested to send their children in full school uniform. Uniforms may be purchased through Cadd's Surf and Sport, Fitzgerald St, Northam. Some second hand uniforms are available through the school office or the Red Cross shop.

## Hats

Hats are compulsory all year. The school recommends a wide brim or bucket hat, however legionnaire hats are acceptable. Visors are not acceptable due to the inability to provide sufficient sun protection.

*The school has a school hat which is reversible with the faction colour. These are available for a cost of \$11.00 through the school office.*

## Faction Shirts

Northam Primary has 'Faction Fridays'. On Fridays students are encouraged to wear a faction shirt and turn their hats to the faction colour every Friday. Faction shirts are available through Cadd's Surf and Sport but may be purchased through any supplier.
